Courses in teaching and learning in higher education as part of research studies

At its meeting on 27 September 2012, the Research Studies Teaching Committee (FU-kollegiet) discussed credit transfer from courses in teaching and learning in higher education to research studies. The teaching committee has tasked the director of studies with submitting the following proposal, and to request the department board to decide accordingly:

A doctoral student in Sociology or Social Anthropology is not eligible for credit transfer for courses in teaching and learning in higher education. The doctoral student should complete such training as part of their departmental duties, and thereby have their period of research studies extended with the corresponding amount of time, up to the equivalent of 7.5 credits.

A doctoral student in Education can *either* transfer credits from courses in teaching and learning in higher education, *or* choose to complete such training as part of their departmental duties, and thereby have their period of research studies extended with the corresponding amount of time, up to the equivalent of 7.5 credits.

The new rules are to apply from the date of the decision.
